Most of the teachers like blue and red, other colors mentioned were lavender and green.

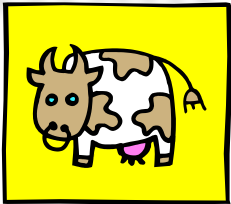
