- ◆ Musical instrument lessons offered

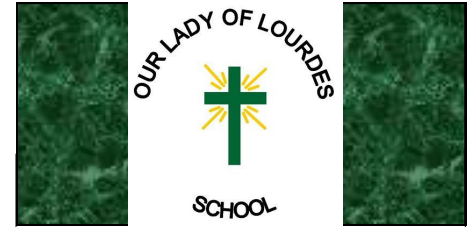
